"People must work to eat every day - they are saying they either go outside and die of Covid 19 or stay inside and starve to death - these are their only choices

Staying indoors for one full day will mean that the family will go hungry

You could have 10 to 12 people living together in one room of 10 x 15 feet

The spread of coronavirus to countries with poor health systems and limited access to clean water will be devastating.

CAFOD is channelling its resources to assist by;

- Delivering food to where it is needed most.
- Improving hygiene, hand washing and sanitation at the community and household level.
- Producing radio messages, posters and leaflets in local languages on risks and prevention.
- Funding training for clergy and lay people to educate their parishes and to carry out campaigns.
